Message from Principal Dear Parents & Caregivers,

As you are aware there have been reported community cases of COVID in the north of Vietnam. We have had to put in place some very strict measures.

- No outside visitors to the school. If parents need to visit the school, please make an appointment (preschool parents can drop off and pick up).
- All students, staff and parents on school grounds must wear a face mask when outside of the classroom, unless exercising. Stock up on extra masks if required.
- Temperature checks upon entering school grounds.
- Regular hand sanitizing entry, before and after meals, classes etc.
- No outside excursions or field trips until further notice.
- No whole school assemblies or gathering of large groups.
- If students have any symptoms fever, sore throat, cough etc please keep them home from school and get checked by a Doctor.

You may need to also carefully consider any upcoming travel plans. If staff or students visit any area where there have been recorded community cases of COVID, they will likely be required to do a 2-week quarantine period and have a health check before returning to school. Please check your email over the holiday period for any updates from the school.

We have completed the teaching and learning cycle with our recent Parent Teacher Conferences. Overall, the Semester results were very pleasing. This data (below) is supported by our results from external testing from the International Schools Assessment (ISA), where we had very strong Mathematical results. The results below are a reflection of hard work by both students and staff.

English:

- 91% of students working at a C grade or higher.
- 31% of students working above 90% (A grade).

Mathematics:

- 92% of students working at a C grade or higher.
- 41% of students working above 90% (A grade).

Science:

- 90% of students working at a C grade or higher.
- 48% of students working above 90% (A grade).

We are now clearly focused on the Semester 2 program. Please take on the feedback and advice given at the Parent Teacher Conferences and assist in supporting students to read

Message from SVIS Principal

Dear Parents

In January 2021, Semester 1 assessment was conducted under the instructions of MOET. Overall results as below:

1. Primary:

- 100% of students made satisfactory academic progress.
- 80.49% students had excellent achievement.
- 99.39% of students have completed for behavior and academic results.

2. Secondary

- 61 students had excellent achievement (67.03%)
- 25 students got good achievement (27.47%)
- 4 students had average achievement (4.39%).
- 1 student had weak result (1.11%)
- 91 students received good behavior (100%).

Other Activities:

- Continue taking part in chess competition in District Level. Ngo Tuan Khoi Year 6 won bronze medal, and 5 students of Year 8&9 who selected into the Basketball competition in the City Level won Silver medal.
- Parent Teacher Interview is at the end of Semester 1: Teachers will update the academic result in Semester 1 and receive parent's contribution ideas to consider adjusting in accordance with Semester 2. The detail information as below:
 - On 16th January (9:00-11:00), Parent Teacher Interview for Year 1 Integrated
 - On 23 January (8:00am-12:00am), Parent Teacher Interview for the rest of the classes
- Year 9 students took part in the national talented student competition of English subject (the 2nd round) as DOET's instruction. All of three students won the good results and continue joining the city level competition in Semester 2 as DOET's instruction.

Due to COVID restrictions we need to postpone the "Tet Fair" and celebrations scheduled for 5/2. We apologise and hope to have an event where we can celebrate Vietnamese Culture later in the year.

On behalf of the school, we would like to thank parents who have accompanied the school to achieve many good results in the Semester 1.

Message from Deputy Principal (Primary)

Dear Parents

We are celebrating **DynEd Week** Feb 1-5 to create awareness of and encourage participation in our *DynEd* Program. We will be having some in-class activities provided by Mr Dan Jones, and there will be a Pizza Party (from Pegasus) for the primary and high school classes, who use *DynEd* the most in the month of January. We will also have individual book prizes for students who use *DynEd* and certain features the most and those who have made the greatest progress.

Developing English language skills is hard work. By consistently using the *DynEd* program our students will progress in their development of the English language. For students Grade 3 and above we strongly recommend regular *reading* and participation on the *DynEd* Program for a

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minimum of 3 x 20 minute sessions per week. For students with a C grade or below for English, we recommend 4 or 5 x 20 minute sessions each week.

Some students are not using this program regularly enough at home to benefit and we urge parents to not allow excuses. The partnership between home and school is very important to make improvements. If at any point a student says they do not have homework (highly unlikely), it is an expectation they either read or participate on *DynEd*. Over the TET holidays we would still like students to access the DynEd program for at least 3 x 20 minute sessions per week. If you could assist by ensuring the students have access to the technology and a gentle reminder this would be greatly appreciated.
