## Afternoon Pick Up

We appreciate your patience, understanding and help to make the Afternoon Pick Up smooth and most importantly safe for you and your students. We would like to remind parents of the procedure for Pick Up. Parents and drivers of Kindergarten children need to park in the designated parking lot.

Please do not stop to park at the roundabout but move directly, using the leftmost lane, to the parking area.

Parents and divers picking up Primary and Secondary students drive through the roundabout, on the rightmost lane, closest to the curb. Parents can help by writing **the name and year level of the children to be picked up and placing it in the car window**. This will be especially helpful in the rainy season. Ms. Cate will help by calling out students' names. We need your help to ensure the safety of all.

#### Early Dismissals

Please send a note or call the school if you intend to pick up your child early. This is especially important for students taking the school buses as time is spent accounting for children. Students will require a 'Permission to Leave the School Grounds' pass to exit the school grounds early. Security will not allow students to leave without permission. To obtain this pass the student must present an explanatory note or confirmation phone call from their parents/care taker to the reception desk in Administration.

#### Late Arrivals

Students who arrive at school after 8:30am must report to the Administration to sign in. Parents are required to provide a note outlining a valid reason for their lateness.

#### Absences

On returning to school from absence a student must produce a note of explanation from their parents to their Form class teacher on their first day back at school. For all absences, parents are requested to ring the school to notify the office on the day of the absence. This is especially important for students who use the school bus service.
