Dear Parents

In May, 2019, teachers in the integrated program focused on revision for examinations, learning assessment and classification of students for the end of the year.

Before taking examinations, students practiced and reviewed the concepts taught throughout the semester. We are pleased to announce that the students have achieved excellent results. Results for Semester 2 examinations:

- o 100% of our students completed learning and practiced assignment;
- o 23 students in Year 5 completed primary school;
- 12 students in Year 9 (100%) graduated from secondary school (66,7% Excellent; 33,3% Good)

Our students will continue with their studies in order to finish the school year 2018 – 2019. For the rest of the year, students will learn from the life skills education curriculum which suits each student's age. Students will also spend their time practicing their performances for the school concert.

On May 31, 2019, 5 our students were awarded prizes in the DOET ceremony at Ngu Hanh Son district.

- 1. Nguyen Trang Nhi, Year 6B, was rewarded by DOET with the title of "Excellent Athlete" in District level and won Gold medal in City level;
- 2. Dong Quoc Tri Year 7 international won silver medal in city level;
- 3. Nguyen Gia Hung Year 8 International won swimming prize in the city level;
- 4. Nguyen Hoang Ha 1A won an impressive letter award (UPU international letter competition in district level);
- 5. Tran Hoang Phuong Di 4B won first prize in literacy in district level.

Finally, there will be a parent meeting at 9:00 am on 8 June, 2019 for all parents of the SVIS students. The Closing Ceremony for our school year will be held at 2:30 pm on 14 June, 2019
