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#### **Message from Deputy Principal (Secondary)**

Dear Parents,

Cambridge Exam time is here! Exams began on 17 April with our IGCSE2 Second Language English Speaking Exam and will continue until 13 June with our A-Levels Economics Exam. Our IGCSE2, AS-Level and A-Level students will take various exams over the next two months. Our staff and teachers are so excited for students to have their time to shine and show all they have learned in their IG and A-Levels programs.

Many families find the time just before and during exams tough for a couple of reasons. Firstly, the exams are rigorous and require strong knowledge. Secondly, there is always a degree of pressure for families during this time.

Parents are a key component in student success, and there are many ways that parents and families can support and encourage students.

1. Keep Calm and Carry On

Work to help students maintain a normal routine during this stressful time. Students are under heavy pressure and need to feel loved, supported and encouraged. Be positive and let them know you are there for him or her.

2. Talk to Your Child About Their Exam Topics

Encourage your child to talk about what he or she has learned. This will help consolidate knowledge and make him or her feel confident.

3. Insist on Wind-Down Time and Regular Breaks

Most students are incredibly studious and take their learning seriously. They likely need to be reminded to work less, not more. Staying up all night to revise is not wise, nor are long days without a break. Time relaxing at the end of the day will prepare your child for sleep, which he or she needs.

#### **Message from Deputy Principal (Primary)**

Dear Parents,

I am writing to inform you that the Semester 2 exams for Y1-Y12 students will take place from Friday, May 24th, to Thursday, May 30th. These exams will count towards 50% of the student's final grades, while the remaining 50% will come from classroom assessments. Integrated students in Y1-Y12 will complete English papers 1-4. International students in Y1-Y8 will complete English papers 1-4, as well as math and science exams. The exam dates are as follows:

- •English Paper 1 (Speaking) will be held from Friday, May 24th to Wednesday, May 29th.
- •English Paper 3 (Language Comprehension) will be held on Friday, May 24th.
- •English Paper 2 (Writing) will be held on Monday, May 27th.
- •English Paper 4 (Listening) will be held on Tuesday, May 28th.
- •The mathematics exam will be held on Wednesday, May 29th.
- •The science exam will be held on Thursday, May 30th.
